



Valley Machining Firm Earns ISO Certification

Southwest Swiss Precision Machining, Inc. Now ISO9001:2015 Certified

Southwest Swiss Precision Machining, Inc. (SSPM) is a Tempe-based precision machine shop, serving the Valley manufacturing community for over ten years. In November, they achieved the important milestone of receiving ISO-9001:2015 certification.

“We have been compliant with the ISO guidelines since opening our shop in 2008,” say owners Jeff and Paulette Gaffney. “While our customers weren’t demanding that we be certified, we felt it was important to take this step to demonstrate that we consistently follow the ISO guidelines and procedures for a quality management system.”

SSPM supplies the aerospace, medical, military and commercial industries with cost-effective Swiss Screw machining services. Their team of highly-qualified machinists use state of the art Citizen Swiss CNC screw machines to manufacture components out of various materials and with extremely tight tolerances. Materials include, but are not limited to, Aluminum, Brass, Beryllium Copper, Inconel, Monel, Titanium, Waspaloy, Delrin and Nitronic 60.

“By combining our ability to deliver machining tolerances as close as .0002-inches, our CNC Swiss machining services meet the most exacting requirements,” says founder Jeff Gaffney. “What makes us unique is our capability to make perfect parts, holding tight tolerances, and to run the hard material and super alloys that our clients need. Being a precision machine shop, our customers can have confidence that we are capable of making their multi-feature, sophisticated parts.”

Gaffney explains that their late-model Citizen machines are equipped with automatic bar loaders, sub-spindles and live-tooling to control the cost of manufacturing products. Swiss Screw machining allows them to manufacture small, complex components for production runs of 500 to 150,000.

SSPM prides itself on consistently achieving close tolerances on parts for all customers, understanding the importance of exacting quality. “We manufacture the hardware that our aerospace and military customers use to assemble larger components that go into engines or other parts of an airplane,” says Gaffney. “Anything less than exact quality could have catastrophic results.”

In the medical industry, SSPM manufactures components used for laser surgery and pins that are used in artificial limbs, where precision has a human impact. They also manufacture commercial components for off-road vehicles, vintage motorcycle speedometers,

wire strippers, screws for clamping fixtures, locations pins for fixtures, Chiropractic tool components and more.

SSPM is located in Tempe and runs two shifts out of their 6,000 square foot climate-controlled facility.

The ISO Certification Journey

SSPM began their quest for ISO-9001:2015 in early 2019. They enlisted expert advice from Tanya Perkins with the Arizona Manufacturing Extension Program (AZ MEP), which led them to ISO consultant, Brett Kelly, owner of Business Management Systems Consulting (BMSC).

SSPM began working with BMSC in April 2019. “Bretta and the BMSC team simplified the entire process for us,” says Paulette Gaffney. “Not only
